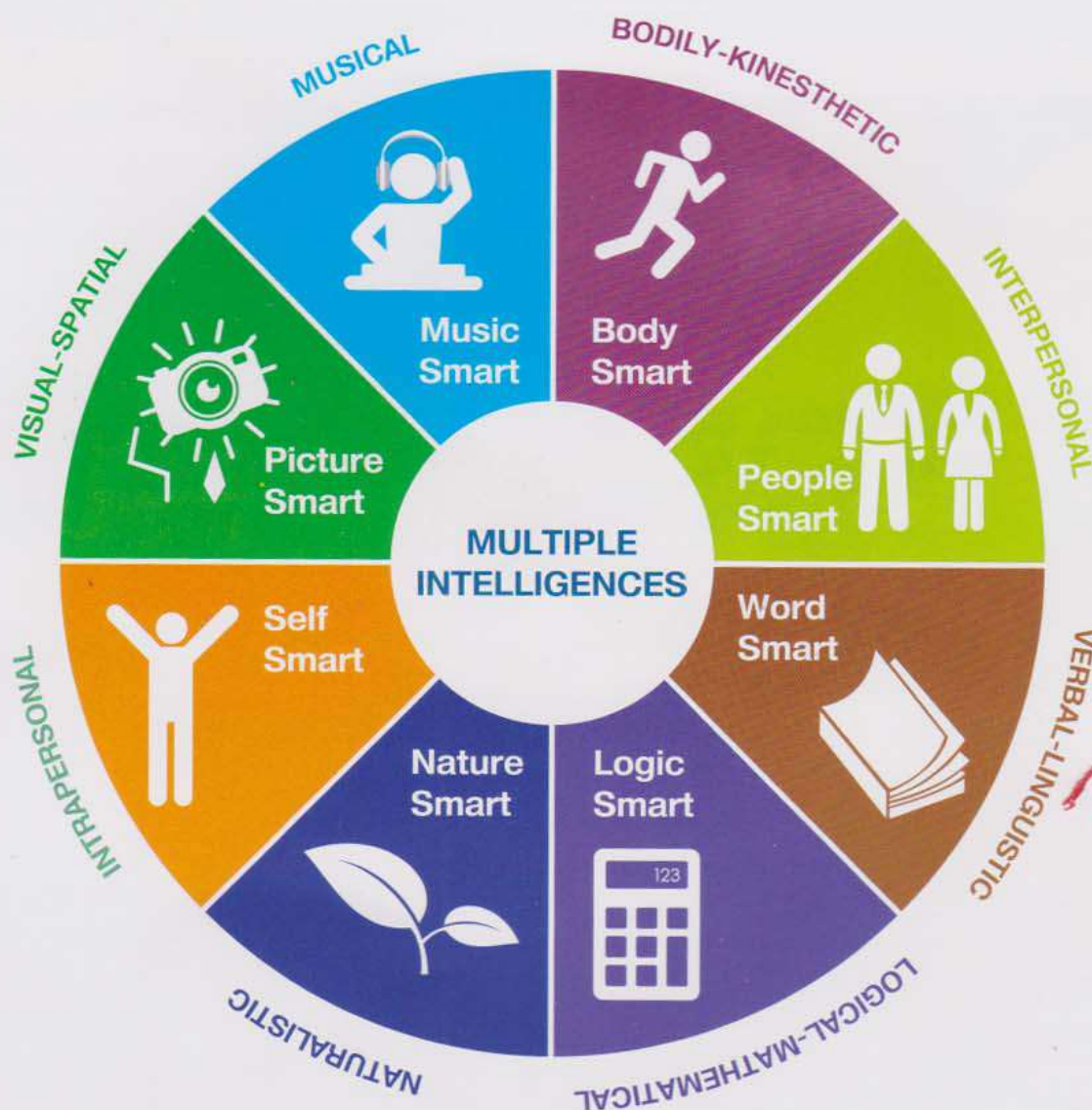
SCHOOL AT A GLANCE

Each child in our KG section is groomed in such a manner that his multi-dimensional personality blossoms into a wholesome child with well developed traits of character.





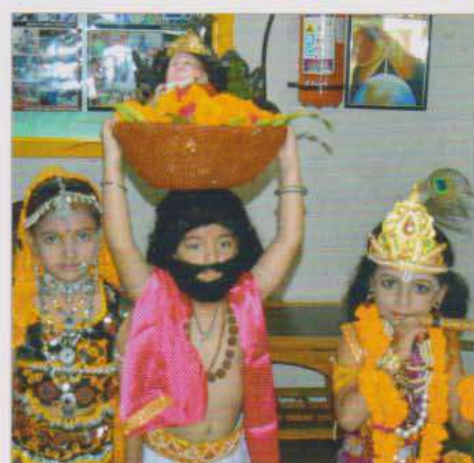
CLASS ACTIVITIES : I DO I LEARN

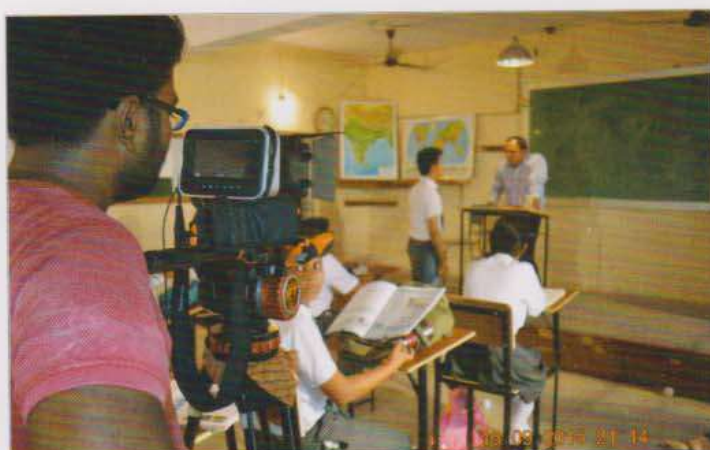

DEMONETISATION IN INDIA

Demonetisation is a process by which a series of currency will not continue to be legal tender. The series of currency will not be acceptable as valid currency. The same thing happened with demonetisation of the Rs. 500 and Rs. 1000 notes.

Objectives of Demonetisation

1. Elimination of fake currency
2. Inflicting losses on those with black money
3. Turning India into cashless economy
4. Disrupting terror and criminal activities,
5. Enabling growth in bank credit
6. Increase tax paying popularity

Impact of demonetization

There is a huge impact of demonetization of Rs. 500/- and Rs. 1000 currency. Because it consists of 84% of money in circulation.

Other impacts will be as under:-

- 1) Liquidity crunch : it means people are not able to get sufficient currency for their daily needs.
- 2) Welfare loss for the currency using population : the daily wage earners, other laborers, small traders, etc. who reside out of the formal economy uses cash frequently. These sections will lose income in the absence of liquid cash. Lack of cash will force firms to reduce labour cost reduces income to the poor working class.
- 3) Consumption will be hit : - when liquidity shorting is there, people will reduce their consumption to minimum.
- 4) Loss of growth momentum : - India risks its position of being the fastest growing large economy. Reduced consumption, income, investment may reduce India's GDP growth as the liquidity impact itself may last 3 – 4 months.

Impact on black economy

Only a small portion of black economy is actually stored in the form of cash. Usually black income is kept in the form of physical assets like gold, land, buildings, etc. Hence the amount of black money reduced by demonetisation depend upon the amount of black money held in the form of cash and it will be smaller than expected.

Advantages of demonetization

1. Attack on black money holders
2. End of terrorist funding
3. End of huge donations
4. End of Hawala transactions

Disadvantages of demonetisation

1. Rush at banks
2. Shortage of money to common people
3. Short term inflation

MORBI CERAMIC INDUSTRIES

Morbi is most promising ceramic tiles manufacturing hub of India, The main products of the ceramic city are vitrified tiles, Wall tiles, Floor tiles, Quartz stone, sanitary ware, roofing tiles and mosaic tiles.
